Wednesday 15th August is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This has been restored as a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be 3 Masses in the parish that day, 10.00 am and 6.30 pm at St Wulstan's and 12.00 noon at Holy Family. Please make every effort to fulfil your obligation that day.

The Harvington Pilgrimage will be on Sunday 2nd September with Principle Celebrant Rt Rev Robert Byrne, Auxilliary Bishop of Birmingham. Mass is at 3.00 pm preceded by Confessions 1.45 - 2.30 pm. Remember to bring your own chair. Free timed tours of the Hall can be booked on the day. There is ample free parking, however, if you wish to walk there will be a group leaving from outside St Wulstan's after morning Mass (around 11.00 am). The whole walk takes approximately 2 hours so you will arrive in good time for picnic lunch and confession. For those who prefer a shorter walk it is possible to join the pilgrims en-route. See details on noticeboards. Please sign the list with your emergency contact number if you wish to be part of the walk.
