Don't forget that Friday is **Cafod Family Fast Day**. The first ever Family Fast day was organised by a group of Catholic women back on 11th March 1960. The success continued and two years later CAFOD became a registered charity. So it is perhaps appropriate that this year's Fast Day occurs on the **World Day of Prayer** which is organised by the Women's World Ecumenical Movement. 
