UPDATE FROM the FUND-RAISING COMMITTEE

We would like to keep you informed of progress on the Church extension (now essentially complete) and our continued efforts to pay off the debt that the Parish is left with.

Recent Progress

We have installed central heating in the Church, rearranged the sacristy with suitable cupboards as well as the addition of the disabled toilet, lift and small unity room. The car park has also been tarmacked.

All of these improvements add value to our life as a parish.

Fundraising Strategy

The Committee has settled on 4 future streams of raising money.

1. 4 events per year (e.g. quizzes, concerts etc).
2. 4 second collections per year.
3. 4 commercially rented car parking spaces (already allotted)**
4. Continuing efforts to raise money from various charitable funds.

With your help, and various charitable trusts, £88,500 has already been raised. Monies so far paid out amount to £124,000 leaving a **deficit of £35,500**.

We look forward to your continued support to pay off this Parish debt as quickly as possible. Thank you.
