



## PHILIPPINES *update*

FROM THE CATHOLIC CHARITY SPICMA

Thanks to your generosity, Spicma has sent £136,200 to the Mill Hill Fathers working in some of the worst hit areas following November's devastating typhoon. With this money, the Fathers have been able to organise initial medical care, safe drinking water, food, seeds for crops, corrugated steel for roofing of replacement homes and fishing boats, many of which were totally destroyed.



However your help is still needed. Many more fishing boats are urgently required, as fishing provides the major source of food for families. A large boat with engines, nets and lights suitable for deep water fishing (pictured) will cost about £690. (These boats will support 10 families enrolled in a co-operative). Individual family boats with nets and equipment more suited to shallow water will cost approximately £158.



While these costs seem good value to us in the UK, in local terms, they are beyond the means of an ordinary family.

In addition, some families still urgently need shelter and we would like to help them by providing the necessary materials. These cost in the region of £148 per home.
