Responses for Saturday Vigil Mass

Entrance Antiphon Peter the Apostle, and Paul the teacher of the gentiles, these have taught us your law, O Lord.

Responsorial Psalm: Their word goes forth through all the earth.

Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Lord, you know everything; you know I love you. Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon: Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these? Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you.

Responses for Sunday Masses

Entrance Antiphon: These are the ones who, living in the flesh, planted the Church with their blood; they drank the chalice of the Lord and became the friends of God.

Responsorial Psalm: The angel of the Lord rescues those who revere him.

Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church. And the gates of the underworld can never hold out against it. Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon: Peter said to Jesus: You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus replied: You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church.

The Peter's Pence collection is a gesture of solidarity. It represents a small offering, accompanied by grand desires and visions. It is an offering that each member of the faithful decides to give to the Pope so that he can provide for the needs of the entire Church, especially in those places where the Church experiences the greatest difficulties. Traditionally, the Peter's Pence collection takes place throughout the Catholic world, usually on the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. Please give generously, thank you.
